The annual CEL Survey is an important instrument for Hunt to understand what we are doing well and what we need to work to improve. The CEL survey is

available to all military housing residents throughout the country. It is controlled and administered by an independent, third-party who reports the results simultaneously to us and the Department of Defense. Across the Hunt portfolio of communities, we have an average of over 50% of our residents who respond. This response rate is statistically high, but we want to continue to encourage our residents to respond in as large numbers as possible, so we get an accurate view of what is occurring within the communities.

Our goal is 100% satisfaction. When we fall short, we want to know so we can fix any problems before they become bigger issues. We also want to know which of our communities have high satisfaction rates so we can share best practices.

Maintenance Corner

*Inspect your smoke detectors. Make sure there is one on each floor of your home. Test them monthly, and change the battery annually or as needed.

*Check your electrical outlets for potential fire hazards such as frayed wires or loose-fitting plugs. Be sure not to overload electrical outlets, fuse boxes, extension cords or any other power service.

*Countertops - Hot pots/pans should not be placed directly on your countertops. Use hot pads to protect the surface. Do not chop any food directly on your countertops. This could cause scratching. Clean your countertops with a soft detergent such as Soft Scrub to avoid wear/ damage to the finish.

*Unplug Household Items Not in Use - Reduce energy waste and your electric bill. Unplug items not in use (lights, TVs, DVD players, computers, game consoles, cell phone chargers etc.) or use a surge protector and simply flip the switch to the off position. Surge protectors will also protect your electronics from power surges.

Coming soon.....Conway homes will soon be winterized. The maintenance staff will go around to all Conway style homes and turn off the water to the outside spigots. The spigots will remain off until the spring to prevent the possibility of outside pipes from bursting during the winter. <u>The date will be sent</u> out via email.
