### NAME CHANGE

Fort Lee, a Hunt Military Community, located in Richmond, Virginia, will soon be renamed. This large base of over 1500 military homes is one of several Army bases undergoing a name change. Effective April 27, 2023, Fort Lee will be renamed Fort Gregg-Adams. The new name honors Lt. Gen Arthur Gregg and Lt. Col Charity Adams. Gregg was a key figure in the integration of black soldiers into the Army. Adams was one of the highest-ranking female soldiers in World War II. Other Army bases receiving name changes include Fort Benning-Fort Moore; Fort Bragg-Fort Liberty; Fort Gordon-Fort Eisenhower; Fort A.P.Hill-Fort Walker; Fort Hood- Fort Cavazos; Fort Pickett-Fort Barfoot; Fort Polk- Fort Johnson; and Fort Rucker- Fort Novosel.

## **MAINTENANCE CORNER**

#### Maintenance Tips for your Garbage Disposal:

Since we throw all kinds of junk into our garbage disposal, it is only logical that it will need a little care and attention on a regular basis.

- After use, make sure to always run the machine with cold water for a minute with dish soap inside. Cold water will help solidify any grease so it can be chopped up before hitting the trap.
- Along with minor periodic maintenance, it is important to remember proper upkeep. An easy way to do this is to toss a chopped-up lemon or orange into the disposal once or twice a month. The citric acid from the fruit helps break up any buildup of grease, and, as an added bonus, it smells great.

If the garbage disposal is giving off a particularly nasty smell, just pour 4 tablespoons of Borax down the drain and leave it to sit for an hour or so before rinsing with hot water.





