NSA Mid-South is committed to an active multi-faceted (i.e. clear plastic bottles/aluminum, newspapers, office paper, cardboard) recycling program. Our base recycling efforts generate profits that are returned to Navy programs such as: Safety, Environmental programs, and/or MWR.

Pest Control Prevention:

Spring is in full swing and this is the time of year that we start seeing an increasing amount of pest and unwanted critters. Here are some tips to help prevent these unwanted nuisances.

*Keep the carport/porch areas clear of clutter and trash.

*Do not keep pet food outside for an extended period of time.

*Dispose of pet waste immediately. *This will prevent odor as well.

*Mowing and weed eating grassy areas.

*Keep all trash in plastic bags and in refuse bins.

*Wipe up spilled food or drinks immediately.

*Rinse empty soda containers and place in trash receptacles.

*Store food in airtight containers.
