Cooking Fats, Oils and Grease

Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG) aren't just bad for our personal health; they are bad for the health of our sewer system as well. When FOG is washed down the drain, it can build up and block the entire pipe. This can result in raw sewage backing up and overflowing into buildings, streets or the rivers.

- Never pour cooking fats, oils, or grease down the sink drains.
- Pour waste liquid cooking oil and grease into a metal can (soup, vegetable, etc.) Let the grease cool and solidify. Then place it in the garbage can for disposal.
- Scrape or wipe grease and food scraps from plates, pots, utensils, and cooking surfaces into the trash for disposal.
- Do not put grease or greasy foods down garbage disposals. Put baskets/strainers in sink drains to catch food scraps and other solids, and empty the drain baskets/
