Specific Storm Water Issue: Cooking Fats, Oils and Grease

Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG) aren't just bad for our personal health; they are bad for the health of our sewer system as well. When FOG is washed down the drain, it can build up and block the entire pipe. This can result in raw sewage backing up and overflowing into buildings, streets or the rivers.

- Never pour cooking fats, oils, or grease down the sink drains.
- Pour waste liquid cooking oil and grease into a metal can (soup, vegetable, etc.) Let the grease the garbage can for disposal.
- Scrape or wipe grease and food scraps from plates, pots, utensils, and cooking surfaces into the trash for disposal.
- Do not put grease or greasy foods down garbage disposals. baskets/strainers in sink drains to catch food scraps and other solids, and empty the drain baskets/

cool and solidify. Then place in it in NSA Public Works Department and our Maintenance technicians have asked that residents not flush handy wipes or any other form of wipes down the toilet drains. This is causing ongoing issues with the sewer pump stations. Clogs are occurring frequently due to wipes being in the sewer system and it is not an easy fix anyone.
