Maintenance Corner— Check Your Filters! Just because your cooling system gets cool doesn't mean it's working efficiently. To get the longest life out of your cooling system, change the filters at least once each month. Also, check thermostat batteries. Remember, an ideal temperature setting is 68 for heating and 78 for cooling.
