#### Winter is Upon Us:

It appears winter is here! Are you ready? Winter weather can leave communities without utilities or other services for long periods of time. Making sure you and your home is ready for winter is very important. Hopefully, we can minimize the effects of the winter storms and freezing temperatures by being prepared for it.

- Turn on faucets so that they drip in occupied homes during extended periods of below freezing temperatures. Dripping faucets can help prevent freeze ups.
- Do not turn off your thermostat while on vacation or away from your home. Maintain a constant temperature.
- Open cabinets during extended periods of below freezing temperatures so that the warm air can reach pipes along exterior walls that are often exposed to the most extreme temperatures.
- Keep in mind, each family member's specific needs, including medication. Have extra batteries for flashlight and radios.
